2014 PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIP

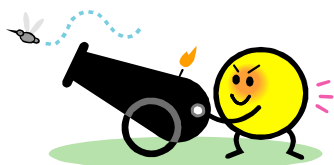


Runners up: Pam & Julia with Winners: Di & Tess

Please continue to familiarise yourself with all the contents.

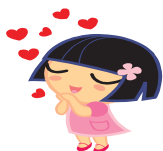
WELCOME TO NEW MEMBERS.
