

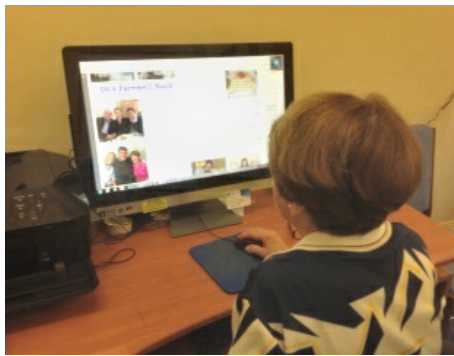

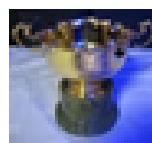

Thanks For The Memories



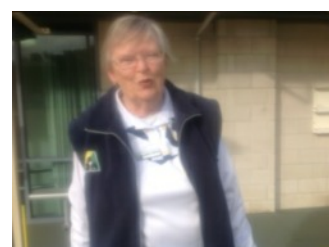
Two in a Row for Gwen
